

GWC KIDS TEAM SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES

Early Childhood Classroom Helper

From Nursery through Kindergarten and First grade, there are a variety of fun ways to capture a child's attention as you sow the Word on their level. Basic Training provided. Should be age 12 or older. Adults are also needed.

Elementary Classroom Helper

Help minister to children or in helping setting up things required for the class. Basic Training provided. Should be age 12 or older. Adults are also needed.

Registration Team

Greet and register children as they enter the classroom, making sure children who check in remain in the classroom until class starts. (Then attend main service.) Re-enter classroom near the end of service to help as children are checked out by parents. Basic training provided.

Drama Teams

Perform short skits in the Kids programs during weekend services (Auditions required)

Office Support for GWC Kids Team

During the week, curriculum copying, filing and general clean up/organizing of Kids Team resource and storage areas. Minimal laundry. Also, a variety of office work including phone calls and computer work.

Media (PowerPoint and Sound Technician)

Operate PowerPoint presentations for the purpose of worship lyrics and Bible lessons in G-force. Help setup and run computer displays and sound systems.

Worship Teams (Vocalists and Experienced Musicians)

Lead children into the presence of God by singing or playing songs similar to those sung in the main sanctuary (Auditions required.)

G-Note Store

G-note Store is our incentive program for K-5th graders where kids cash in tickets for prizes. Operate and assist children with their purchases. Help order and set "prices" of popular inventory. Training provided.

Outreach/Special Events

Lend a helping hand in special events and outreaches (e.g., Kids' Summer Splash, Kids' Camp, etc.). Be available for childcare during events like New Member's Coffee or Teacher Training events.

Prep Team

Change sheets on cribs in nursery and nursing mothers area before services. Also, set up and tear down chairs, tables, sets, props, banners, and balloons for special Sunday services or special events.

Snack and Resource Inventory

After the service, consolidate snack items and straighten room. Make note of low-stock items and update shopping lists.

Floor Manager*

Must check all classrooms, unlock rooms, and make sure all rooms have enough approved team members and take care of any needs the teachers have for their classes (within reason); be contact for Security team. Check on classes periodically in case needed and be very visible in children's area. More detailed responsibilities and training provided by Director.
